

Please prepare for emergencies on a routine basis.

/ Stockpiling Drinking Water / Notes



In the event of a disaster, it is expected that emergency repairs and the restoration of the water supply will take time due to road disruptions and traffic jams.

Please stockpile drinking water at home and at the workplace.
Yokkaichi City calls for a stockpile of 7 days, with 3 liters per person per day as the criterion.



Stockpiling commercially available bottled water

Considering the hygiene aspect, it is better to stockpile commercially available bottled water. Since it will be difficult to replace all the bottles at once when the expiration date draws near, it is good to stockpile a little more (e.g. 1 case), and consume the water in these bottles little by little regularly. Then finally, replacing the whole case with a new one after it had decreased to some extent. (Reference: There is also bottled water with a long shelf life of 3-7 years for disaster stockpiles)

Preparing plastic water storage containers

When getting water from a water supply station, please make it a point to bring plastic water storage containers or empty 2-liter PET bottles. Furthermore, water is surprisingly heavy. It is better to prepare a bag to put the plastic containers into, or a cart (hand truck).



Water tanker

“Emergency hydrants” are continually being built.

When attached to fire hydrants, these act as emergency water faucets. Since the water pipes are the first to be repaired after a disaster, water supply can be supplemented by using fire hydrants. Emergency hydrants are deployed at designated evacuation centers (including Community Centers), and are made available with the cooperation of the disaster prevention organization and the Waterworks and Sewerage Bureau.

Emergency water supply stations in times of need!

The Yokkaichi City Waterworks and Sewerage Bureau maintains facilities such as “emergency water tanks” that supply drinking water to its citizens when the water supply has been disrupted due to earthquakes, and other disasters. It is prudent to know where the nearest emergency water supply sites are beforehand in case of an emergency.

Bring containers to put water in, such as plastic water storage containers, to the water supply station.

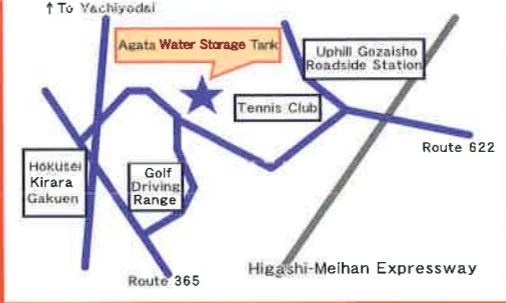


Emergency water tank: An emergency water supply station that supplies water from an emergency water tank in the event of a disaster. (13 locations)

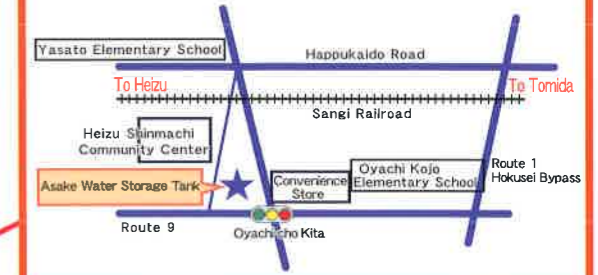


Water storage tank (with emergency shut-off valve): An installation that supplies water to each household, and becomes an emergency water supply station in the event of a disaster. (8 locations)

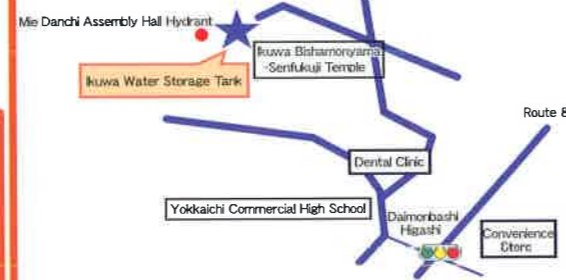

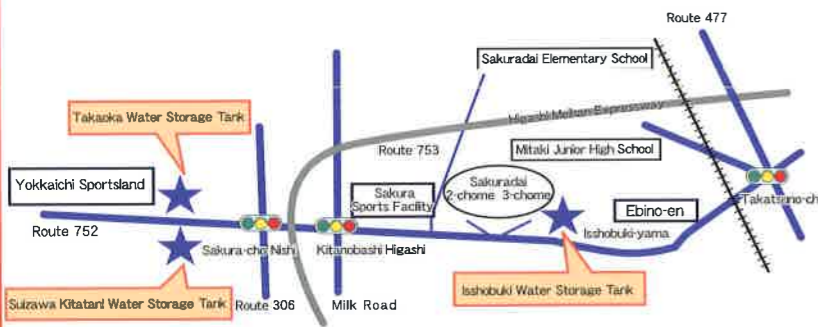
Asake Water Storage Tank (Heizu-cho 41-5)

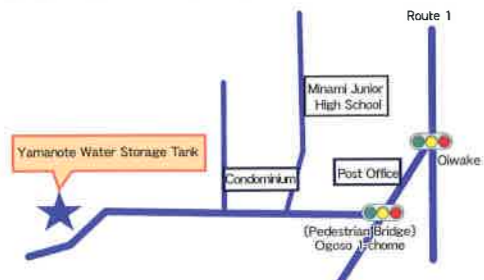

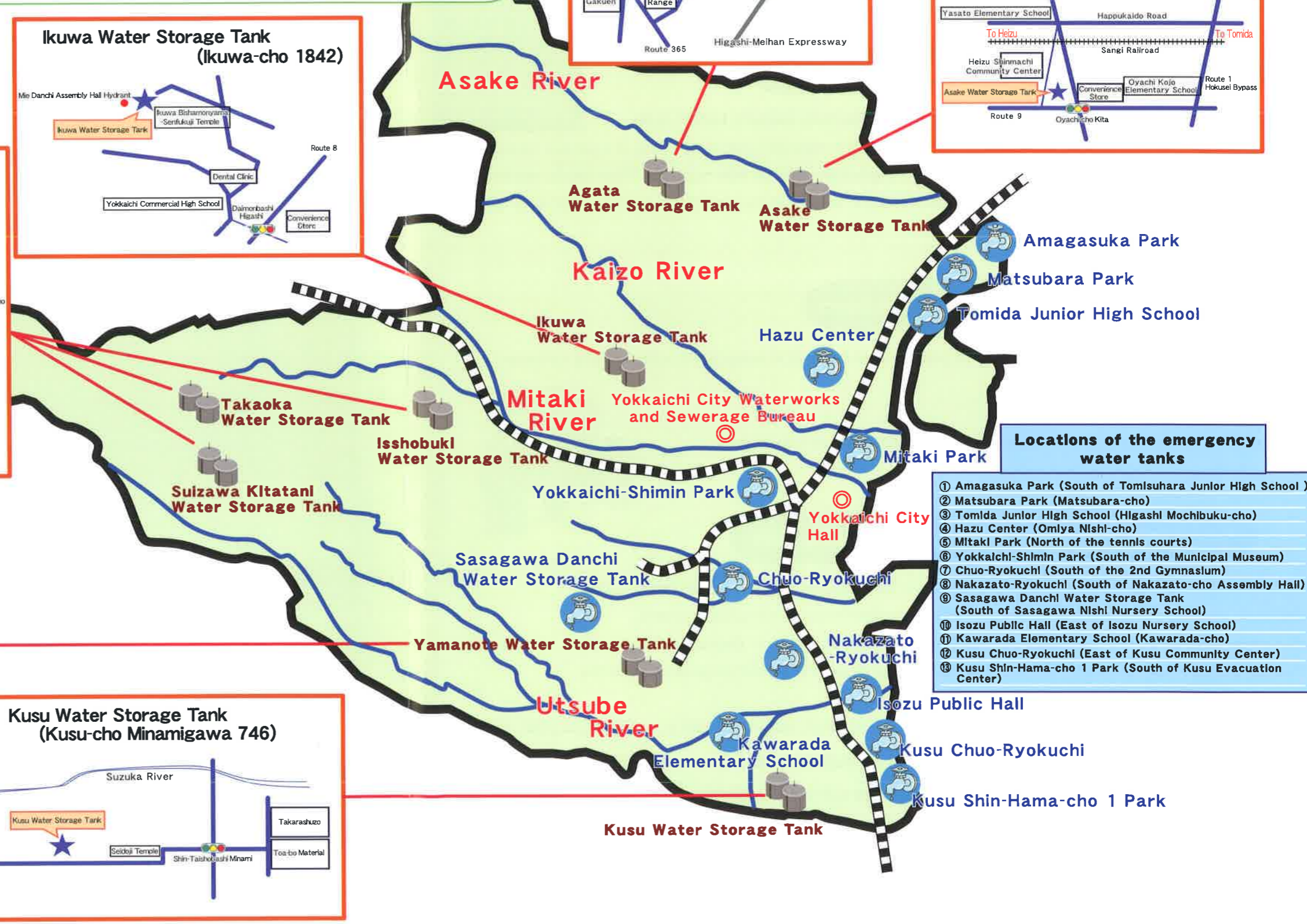
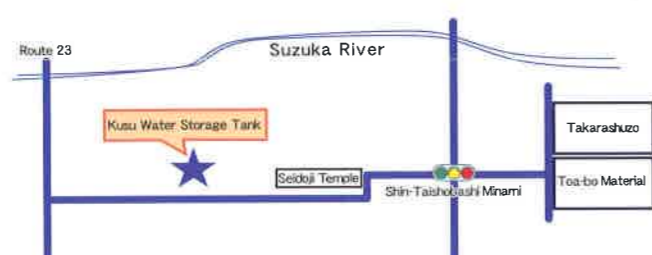
